- 1) **Application Form** (download from GRK 2364 website)
- 2) **Official Transcripts / Record of Studies:** Detailed documentation of your academic work (list of courses attended; grades if applicable)
- 3.) **Certificates:** Certificates of relevant **university examinations** (e.g. Bachelor's and Master's degree) and the certificate giving the **right of admission to higher education** in the applicant's country such as Abitur, Matura, or equivalent (with individual grades). Please include an explanation of the grading system.
- 4) **Proof of proficiency in English** (if applicable): Applicants who are not native speakers of English should demonstrate an adequate competence of the English language by acceptable results in an internationally recognized test (e.g. TOEFL). Participation in such a test is recommended but not mandatory, because language skills can also be evaluated during the personal interviews with selected candidates. Proven higher education in English or a reasonably long stay in an English speaking country are acceptable as equivalents.

## In addition, we request 2 References, sent by your referees directly to us:

References of two academic teachers who can evaluate your personality, academic experience, and intellectual merit. The use of the **Reference Form** (download from the GRK 2381 homepage) is mandatory. Reference Forms must be **sent by the referees via e-mail directly to**

All submitted documents must be in English or German. Certified copies of documents are not mandatory at the time of submission. All relevant documents will be certified prior to acceptance to the program. Note that we are unable to consider applications that are incomplete or do not fulfil the formal criteria described above.
